Another history-making year for the football team began by defeating Westcliffe 34-8. This opening game was the first in a series of wins that saw D&B take its second Black Forest League Championship in two years, with a remarkable 9-1 record. An overtime play lead to the defeat of Westcliffe in the quarterfinal playoffs, and a meager three inches kept the Bulldogs from a possible win over Flagler in the state semifinal playoffs.

State honors went to Bill Ross and Gary Washington, both being named to the All State Offensive and Defensive teams. Eight-man Class A "Player of the Year" was Gary Washington.

Players not returning next year are Gary Washington, Larry Schwarz, Randy Ausmus, Kevin Kreutzer, Pascual Gonzales and Roger Padilla. With our returning men, however, we should have a fine season.

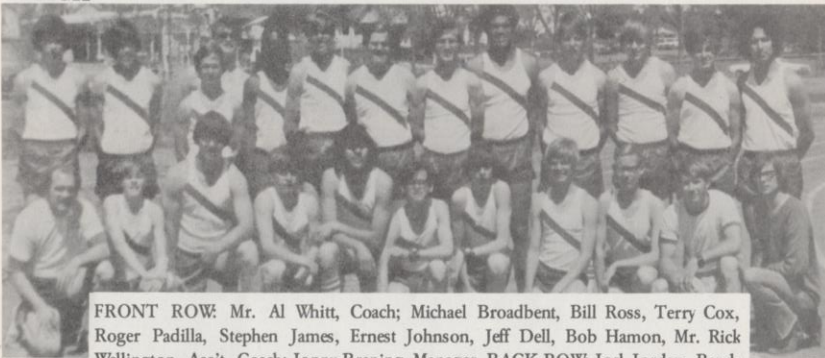

All four boys traveled to Greeley for the State Class-A Wrestling Meet. And what a meet! Larry Schwarz went all the way, lacing first in his weight class and on to the top to be named "Outstanding Wrestler" of the tournament.

A young team, all except Schwarz and Padilla, will be seeing action next year, along with several top prospects from the Junior High team.

Weatherwise, it has been a bad year for track, but despite cancellations and alterations, the new track and field has been put to good use.

The Air Force Academy Easter Races, with entrants Randy Ausmus, Joel Jordan, Bill Ross, and Gary Washington, started off D&B's track season. Gary showed what kind of excitement to expect this season by setting a new record for the Easter Races of 48.9 in the 440 yard dash.

A series of meets brought home the trophies—a first place from Hoehne Invitational Meet, a first in the BFL meet, a 2nd in the Badger Relays, and a 2nd in the District Meet at Limon. Winners in the District meet, and thus qualifiers for the state meet were Gary Washington in the 100, 220, and 440-yard dashes, and mile relay; Randy

Ausmus in the triple jump, long jump, 440-yard dash and mile relay; Bill Ross in the shotput and discus; Joel Jordan for the 2-mile run and pole vault; plus Terry Hanes, Mike Price, and Rex Engstrom (alternate) for the mile relay.

Gary once again shattered school records—22.0 in the 220-yard dash, and 48.9 in the 440. Randy Ausmus set a school record in the triple jump with a leap of 43 feet 2 inches. Heaving the shot put for a distance of 45 feet 2 inches was the new school record holder Bill Ross.

But the big event was the state meet at Limon on May 12. D&B took second place to Walsh (33-28) while defeating a tough third place Limon team. Washington, placing first in the 100, the 220, and the 440, was also named the state's Most Valuable Player.

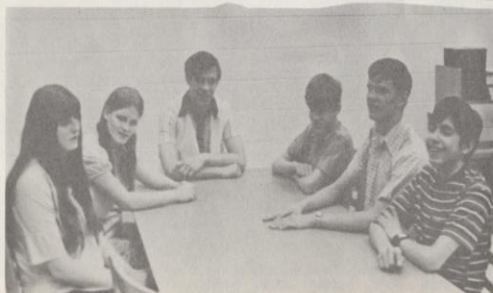
