


Louis Dyers – 1926

- *Lettered 4 years in football, basketball and baseball -1922to 1926.
- *Was a football captain from 1924 and 1925; led his teams to two successful season:
 - -1924 with a record of 5-1-1.
 - -1925 with a perfect record of 7-0.
- *Was inducted into the USA Deaf Sport Federation Hall of Fame in basketball -1962.
- *Was inducted into the Gallaudet University Hall of Fame in football, basketball and baseball-1931.
- *Was a deaf Olympic basketball coach in 1965 (Gold medal).




Richard O'Toole -1942

- *Lettered 4 years in football & basketball 1938 -1942.
- *Was a football team captain -1939 and 1940; played as an end and punter; was a go-to end

and booted average 40 yards.


- *Led his team to the undefeated season in 1941 under Coach Alfred Brown
 - 1939 with a record 5-1
 - 1940 with a record of 3 -2
 - 1941 with a record of 7-0
- *Was 3-time FRAT All-Deaf American in football (1939, 1940, and 1941.
- *Was 3-time high score man for the season. (1940 -1942) with an average of 18.7 point per game in 1942, 16.3 points per game in 1941 and 11.7 point per game in 1940.
- *Played as Center position in basketball and Team records 6-7 in 1940, 11-4 in 1941 not show records in 1942 under Coach Alex Wright.



Coach Joe Sisneros 1966 -1991

- *Was part of the school's football team affiliated with CHSAA to qualify for the state playoffs and to win the school's first
 - *Black Forest League title '69.
 - *Named the Deaf American Coach of the Year in football -'71
 - *Guided the football teams to the state playoffs '69, '71, '72,'73 & '77.
 - *Had three undefeated football regular seasons -'72, '73 & '77.
 - *Named the Gazette Class A-AA All Region Coach of Year -'77.
 - *Named the Deaf American Coach of the Year in basketball -'73
 - *Guided the basketball teams to the District playoffs -'70, '71 & '72.
 - *Inducted into the Colorado High School Activities Association '82.
 - *Coached football, basketball and wrestling for 30+ years.
 - *Had 25 years of teaching/coaching experience.

Gary Washington -1974



- *Was part of the school's football team affiliated with CHSAA to qualify for the state playoffs and to win the school's first Black Forest League title '69
- * Was a member of the '69, '71 & '72 teams which qualified for the state playoffs.
- * Gazette Telegraph All-City in football first team (halfback) '70, '71 & '72
- * 3 time Class A 8-Man Player of the Year -'70, '71 & '72
- * 3 time All State 8-Man in football -'70, '71 & '72
- * 2 time All-Deaf American in football first team (HB)- '71 & '72
- * Deaf Prep Football Player of the Year-'72
- * 3 time All-Conference (Black Forest) in football '70, '71 & '72
- * Was a member of the basketball teams of The Deaf American of the year -'73
- * 2 time All-Conference (Black Forest) in basketball '72 &'73*
- * Deaf Prep All-American in basketball (second team) -'71
- * Deaf Prep All-American in basketball (first team) -'72 & '73
- * National Deaf Prep Trackfest:
 - -best 2nd in 100 yard dash (9.9) -'70, 1st (9.9) -'71, 1st (9.8)-'72 & 1st (9.7) -'73
 - -best 2nd in 220 yard dash (22.4) '70, 1 st (22.2) '71, 2nd (22.2)- '72 & 1st (22.0) '73
 - -best lead in 440 yard dash 49.5) -'70, 1st (49.2) -'71 (Twice New national deaf prep record), 2nd (49.5) -'72 & 1st (48.9) -'73
 - -best lead in one mile relay (3:32.8) -'71,& 3:29.2 -'72 (national deaf prep record) 5th -(3:36.7) '73
- * Was a member of the track teams which won 2nd place in state track '71, '72 & '73
- * 4 time State Qualifier in track 1970 1973
 - -State Champion in the 100 '71, '72 &'73 & State Runner-up '70
 - -State Champion in the 220 '70, '71, '72 & '73
 - -State Champion in the 440 '70, '71, '72 & '73
 - -State Champion in 1-mile relay '71 & '72 & State Runner-up '73
- * Hold school records in track:
 - -100 yard dash (9.7) -'73, held his two previous records in school.
 - -220 yard dash (22.1) -'73, held his two previous records in school.
 - -440 yard run (48.9) '73, held his two previous records in school.
 - -1-mile relay (3:29.1) -'72 & One-mile medley relay 4:00.0 '71
- * Fred Steinmark Athlete of the Year '73
- * 2-time Deaf Olympic Qualifier -'73 in track (3 golds/1 silver) & -'77 in basketball (gold)
