- * Lettered 4 years in football, wrestling & track 1968-1972.
- * Was part of the school's football team affiliated with CHSAA to qualify for the state playoffs and to win the school's first Black Forest League title – '69
- * 2 time Black Forest League All-Conference in football - '70 and '71
- * Gazette Telegraph All-City 2nd team (halfback) -'71
- * All-State in Class A 8-Man football (HB/LB) - '71
- * All-Deaf American in football first team (G)- '71
- * Was a member of the district regional champion in wrestling -'71
- * 3 time District Champion in wrestling - '70, '71 & '72
- * 3 time state qualifier in wrestling -'70, '71 & '72,
- * 2 time State Champion - '70 & '71 and State Runner-Up - '72
- * 2 time Gazette Telegraph Class A-AA Team in wrestling - '71 & '72
- * Colorado Class A Wrestling Outstanding Wrestling - '70
- * National Deaf Prep Trackfest:
 - best 2nd in two-mile run (10:27.8) -'70
 - best 2nd in one-mile (4:39.9) -'71 & 4th (4:40.2) -'72

Jerry Wayne Ferguson -1970

- * Lettered 4 years in football & track 1965 -1969
- * Black Forest League All-Conference in football (Lineman) - '68
- * National Deaf Prep Trackfest:
 - best 4th in discus (136'11") -'67
- * 2-time State qualifier in track - '68 &'69
 - Shot Put - '68 & '69
 - Discus - '68 & '69 (4th place)
- * Set then-school records in
 - Discus - 136'11" - '69

Louis M. Byouk – 1924

- * He was a key member of the 1920 undefeated football team under Coach Alfred Brown's era. He was the two-time captain, 1919 and 1920. He did not only star in football but also in basketball. He led in scoring during his senior year.
- * Led his football teams in rushing - '20, '21, '22 & '23 and to great seasons:
 - 1919 with a record of 6-1
 - 1920 with a record of 7-0
 - 1921 with a record of 6-1
- *Inducted into the Gallaudet University Hall of Fame in football and basketball - 1929
- *Supervisor and Athletic Director at the Berkeley (Fremont) School for the Deaf for more than 35 years.

Coach Alonzo Whitt 1969 – 2002

- * Claimed the Black Forest Conference wrestling titles - '69, '70, '71, '72, '74, '75, '76, '77, '78, '79, '82 & '83
- * Brought the wrestling teams to the district regional
- * District Champions - '71, '76, '78 & '79
- * District Runner-Ups – '69, '72, '74, '75, & '77
- * District Third Place - '70 & '73
- * Placed in Top 10 rankings in state wrestling competitions - '70 - '79
- * Best team finish in the state - '77 (4th place)
- * Coached several wrestling won state champion (10) with 4 Outstanding Wrestling in State
- * Brought the track teams to the district and state competitions - State Runner-Ups '71, '72 & '73
- * District Champion – '72
- * District Runner-Ups - '71 & '73
- * 2-time Deaf Olympic Qualifier – '65 in wrestling (2 silver medals) '69 in wrestling
- * Deaf Olympic Wrestling Coach - '73
- * Inducted into the USA Deaf Sports Federation Hall of Fame in wrestling –1989
- * Had 33 years of teaching/coaching.
