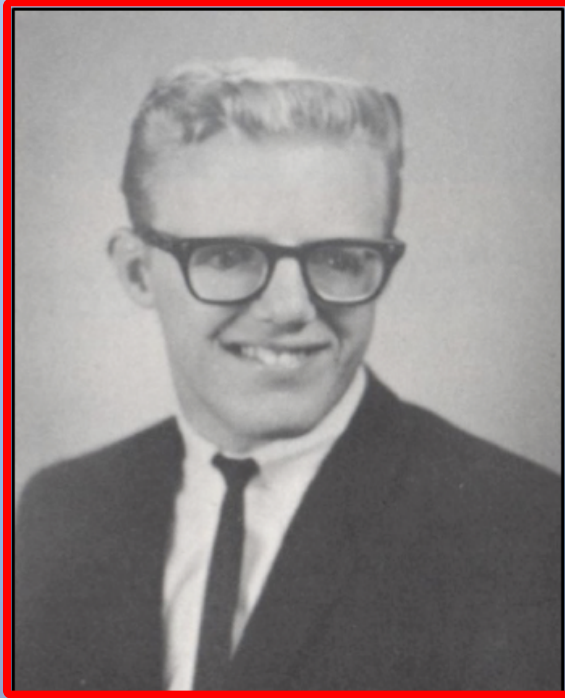


## Hall of Fame -2012



**Larry G. Kopcho – 1967**

- \* Lettered 2 years in football 1965-1966, 7 years wrestling 1961-1967 and 2 years track 1964-1965.**
- \* First blind student qualified for the state wrestling competition**
- \* 2 time District Champion in wrestling - '65 & '67**
- \* District Runner-Up in wrestling - '66**
- \* 3-time State wrestling qualifier – '65, '66 & '67**
- \* State Runner-Up - '66**
- \* State Third Place '67**
- \* 3 time Southwest Association Blind Wrestling Champion –'62, '63 & '64**
- \* 2 time Southwest Association Light Weight Class Outstand Wrestling Tournament -1963-1964**
- \* Black Forest League All-Conference in football (Center) - '66**
- \* Held then-school record in the one-mile relay - 3:52.0 -'64**

## Hall of Fame -2012



**Leslie Bruening – 1968**

- \* Lettered 4 years in football, basketball and track 1963-1967.
- \* 3 time All-Conference (Black Forest) in Football(tackle) -'64,'65 &'66.
- \* All-American Deaf Prep in football special mention (G) -'66
- \* All-Conference (Black Forest) in basketball '66.
- \* Held then -school records in track:
  - Shot Put (43'3 1/4") -'66. held his three previous records in school.
  - Discus (127") -'66. held his two previous records in school.

## Hall of Fame -2012



**Janice Harris– 1963**

- \* Lettered 4 years in volleyball 1959 -1963 and 1 year in basketball - 1963**
- \* Was an integral part of starting the school's athletic program for the girls and was a star player in volleyball for four years**
- \* Was a standout in the school's inaugural basketball program in 1963 and led in scoring with a record of 5-2**

## Hall of Fame -2012



**Bonnie Bodnar – 1980**

- \* Lettered 4 years in volleyball, basketball & track 1976 -1980
- \* 2-time Black Forest League All-Conference in volleyball - '78 & '79
- \* 2-time Black Forest League All-Conference in basketball - '78 & '79
- \* Western State Basketball Classic All-Tournament (First Team) – 1979
- \* Member of the WSBC championship team - '79
- \* All-Deaf American in basketball (special mention to outstanding sophomore freshman) -'78
- \* All-Deaf American in Girl basketball (first team) - '79 & '80
- \* Mythical National Girls Deaf Prep Trackfest:
  - 5th place in shot put (34-4) -'78 & 3rd place (36-6) -'79
  - 7th place in one mile relay (4:44.7) -'78
- \* Set then-school records in track:
  - Shot Put - 37'11 1/2" - '80
  - Discus - 108' - '80
  - 440 yd relay - 54.4 - '80
- \* 4-time State Qualifier in track - '77, '78, '79 & '80
  - Shot Put - '79 (5th place) & '80 (2nd place)
  - Discus - '80 (2nd place)
- \* 2-time Deaf Olympic Qualifier
  - '81 in track (bronze in Shot Put/Discus)
  - '85 in track (gold in Shot Put and Discus)
