


Walter VonFeldt-1968

- \* Lettered 4 years in football, wrestling and track 1963-1967.
- \* Black Forest League All-Conference in football (G) '66
- \* All-American Deaf Prep in football -(G) -'66
- \* 3-time District wrestling qualifier '65, '66 & '67 2nd Place- '65 & '66
- \* 2-time State wrestling qualifier '65 & '66
- \* First deaf student qualified for the state wrestling competition '65
- \* National Deaf Prep Trackfest:
  - -best 3rd in one-mile relay -'67
- \* Held then-school records in track:
  - 1-mile Relay 3:41.0 67
  - 880- yard Relay 1:40.1 64
- \* 4-time Deaf Olympic qualifier:
  - '69 in wrestling (silver medal)
  - '73 in wrestling (bronze medal)
  - '77 in wrestling (silver/bronze medals)
  - '81 in wrestling.




Lynn Ohm- 1959

- \* Lettered 3 years in football & basketball 1956-1959.
- \* FRAT Society All-American in football '59.
- \* Led in football offensive stats and the team to a record of 7-1, the best season since the 1944 season.
- \* 3-time FRAT Society All-American in basketball '57, '58 & '59



Mike Korach - 1932

- \* Lettered 4 years in football, basketball and baseball 1927-1932
- \* Played halfback and led in rushing stats
- \* Guided his teams to beat some top ranked opponents in the state in the 1930s
  - 1931 with a record of 5-2
  - 1932 with a record of 6-1



Ronald Teubner 1957-1988

- \* Football and Wrestling Coach
- \* Instigated the wrestling program for the blind students in 1957 and then the deaf students in 1962.
- \* Became an advocate for the school to affiliate with the Colorado High School Activities Association (CHSAA) in 1964.
- \* Was a wrestling coach for several years; gave the blind wrestlers an opportunity to compete against other blind state schools (Southwest Blind Regional).
- \* Was the key role in creating a full-time position to run the athletic program.
- \* Oversaw the athletic program during his entire years of service at the school (31 years)
- \* Hosted annual wrestling tournaments at CSDB starting in 1962: eventually named the Ron Teubner Invitational Wrestling.
- \* Claimed the Black Forest Conference wrestling titles '82, '83.
- \* Directed the Student Life program for 31 years.
